This is a remarkable achievement for your students. Their work was recognized by a panel of creative professionals as the most outstanding work submitted among their peers, exemplifying the Awards' core values: originality, technical skill, and the emergence of personal voice or vision. These students join the ranks of notable Scholastic Award Winning alumni such as Andy Warhol, Zac Posen, Stephen King, Lena Dunham, John Lithgow, Luis Jimenez, and Robert Redford.

The Scholastic Art & Writing Awards are the country's longest-running and most prestigious scholarship and recognition program for creative students in grades 7–12. Founded in 1923, the Awards have inspired bold ideas in creative teens throughout the country for nearly a century. This is the 27th year the Schack Art Center has been hosting the Art Awards for teens in Snohomish County. The Schack Art Center is the only affiliate in WA State giving access to Snohomish County Students to an exhibition, scholarships, opening reception and virtual ceremony.

This program year, nearly 340,000 works of art and writing were submitted to more than 100 Affiliate Partners across the country. 176 creative teens from the Snohomish County Art Region received 273 regional honors, including Gold Keys, Silver Keys, Honorable Mentions, or American Visions nominations, from local Art Affiliate Schack Art Center.

In celebration of this year's recipients, the public is invited to view the Scholastic Art Exhibitions at the Schack Art Center, 2921 Hoyt Ave. Everett, WA. Portfolio Exhibition will be on display January 18-March 13 in the Emerging Young Artists' Gallery and the Individual Award-Winning Entry Exhibitions will be featured in the Mezzanine Gallery from January 25-February 13. A virtual award ceremony will take place February 3, 6:30 PM. Gallery Hours are as follows: Tuesday-Saturday, 10-5pm; and Sunday, 12-5pm.
